





# Trolley



- Re-started in 2003
- 13 trolleys in fleet - City owns/maintains trolley fleet
- Contract for drivers, dispatchers, etc.
- Operate 8: weekdays, 7: holidays/summer, 6: Saturdays
- Monday - Saturday from 6:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- 8–15 minute headways
- 3 fixed routes (76 total stops)
  - 7-mile loop on Ponce De Leon Blvd – (8-12 minute headway)
  - 1.2-mile loop on Grand Ave - (15-20 minute headway)
  - 5.4-mile Southern Loop - (30-40 minute headway)- State Grant- City \$204,000. State: \$196,000
- Weekday Service: Average 3,800 passengers/day
- Saturday service - Average 1,900 passengers/day
- City of Miami Trolley, Miami Dade Metro-Rail/Bus.



■ Ponce Route ■ Grand Route




# First/Last Mile Trolley Stop Upgrades



- Freebee started June 2017.
- Fleet: 5 Tesla Model X.
- Averages 60,000+ passengers per year.
- Average Wait Time: 11.78 (since expansion Nov 2024)
- FDOT Smart Transportation Grant: City \$22,315. State: \$21,083/month







# Micromobility- Scooters


## Bird

- Pilot program started on Oct 11, 2018.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment: Pilot through Feb 13, 2019
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment: Signed Feb 12, 2019:
- Up to 200 scooters are deployed
- Ridership: 2021-2026: 180,391.
- Averaging 42,500 riders per year.
- Average Distance: 1 mile
- Average Time: 11 minutes
- Safety Measures: User rules, Parking requirements, Geofencing, etc.
